ROOM PARENT Information

Prior to attending school parties as a room parent/helper, you are REQUIRED to attend the Protecting God's Children Class and complete a background check.

<u>Class Parties:</u> St. Elizabeth School classes may have three parties a year. All notes about parties, etc. MUST be approved by the principal.

<u>Halloween:</u> Room Parents provide refreshments and games (to be played in the classroom with teacher approval. Room Parents will also direct the games played.

<u>Valentine's Day:</u> Room Parents provide refreshments. Teachers implement party and games. Teachers may limit celebrations depending on the season of Lent.

Easter: Kindergarten Room Parents assist with an Easter Egg Hunt and party, consult Kindergarten Teacher for details.

<u>Staff Appreciation Luncheon:</u> In May, or during Catholic Schools Week, PTO sponsors an appreciation event. Parents may be asked to volunteer to donate items or supervise students.

<u>Field Trips:</u> Room Parents may be asked to chaperone trips. Chaperones are required to attend the Protecting God's Children Class and complete a background check prior to chaperoning school events. Class trips must consist of designated students and chaperones only. (Additional children may not attend.)

<u>Field Day</u>: Volunteers are needed to make May Field Day a success. Details for events and signups will be sent home in the spring.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- \$25.00 is collected from each student registering for St. Elizabeth School. \$5.00 is designated or class parties, \$10.00 per student is forwarded to the auction committee (baskets/lotto.) The remaining \$10.00 is used for school screenings (hearing/vision/lice.)
- Room parents may donate items to class parties in addition to the monies that are collected.
- No Gift Exchange at Christmas. Birthday invitations may be sent through school provided the entire class is invited.
- Families routinely donate to service projects including food collections and a toy drive at Christmas.
- Grades 7 and 8 are the only classes allowed pizza as a treat (one time a year) at a Room Party.
- Field Trips:

The Following is NOT allowed on Field Trips:

- 1. Leaving the Trip Location
- 2. Leaving the Group unless the Teacher gives specific directions for this.
- 3. Bringing small children on the Field Trip.
- 4. Making stops at other places when returning to school from a field trip, unless designated by the teacher as part of the Field Trip.
