"Father Godwin was born on December 22, 1970, to Stella and Ernest Tindyebwa Mutahigwa in Mbarara, Uganda. He has 8 siblings, (3 boys and 5 girls).

Educationally, he attended Munyonyi Primary School, St. Mukasa Seminary, Kitabi Seminary, Katigondo National Major Seminary, Ggaba National Seminary, Catholic University of Eastern Africa, Kenya, Ndejje University and Mbarara University of Science and Technology. He holds Bachelor's degrees in Philosophy and Theology, Post Graduate Degree in Education, Licentiate/Masters in Biblical Theology and A Doctorate in Education Planning and Administration.

Father Godwin was ordained to the Catholic priesthood on August 2, 1998, for the Archdiocese of Mbarara. He has taught in the diocesan seminary of Kitabi from 1998 to 2004 and later become a Rector of another diocesan seminary at St. Mukasa Seminary from 2007 to 2016. He became a Principal of St. Joseph's Vocational School from 2017 to 2024. He celebrated 25 years of priesthood and was briefly serving at St. Charles Lwanga, Kihani Parish as he prepared to come and serve in the USA. He has been a priest for 27 years. Father Godwin enjoys reading, traveling and basketball."


