Faith Formation Is Alive @ St. Elizabeth!







Faith formation has long been at the heart of the Catholic Church's mission- to proclaim the Gospel, teach the faith, and form disciples of Christ. At St. Elizabeth Church we continue to see remarkable successes in how it nurtures and strengthens the spiritual lives of people of all ages.

The Catholic Church's mission to form hearts and minds in Christ is alive and thriving at St. Elizabeth Church. Through the work of the pastor, catechists, lay leaders, and parents, the Church is not only passing on the faith, but transforming lives. As the Church continues to adapt to new challenges and cultural shifts, one truth remains: formation is essential for the Church's vitality—and it is bearing great fruit.

The following information illustrates exactly how the Holy Spirit continues to move throughout our faith community:

Baptisms: 20 children (7 years or younger) have become Children of God

Confirmations: 3 children have completed their Sacraments of Initiation by being Confirmed at Pentecost by the Bishop in Springfield.

RCIA/OCIA: 12 total people received into Full Communion at Easter Vigil These 12 received all 3 Sacraments of Initiation

In addition, 6 adults received Eucharist and Confirmation (4 on Nov. 14 and 2 at Easter Vigil) These adults had previously been Baptized in a different faith, but are now in Full Communion with the Catholic Faith.
